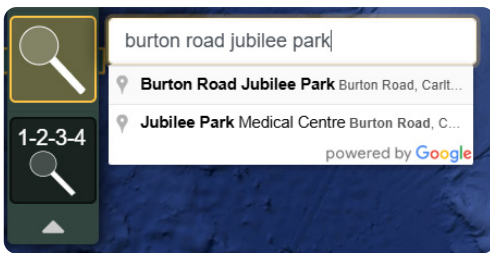




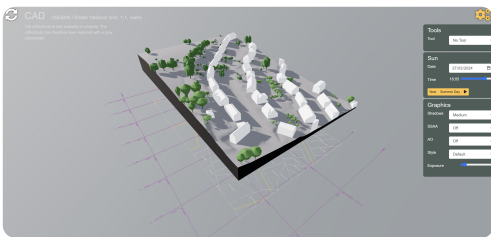
## A Guide to Getting started with Cetopo

Cetopo is a platform allowing architects, designers, and developers to access site and context models with unprecedented speed, and in exactly the format they need.



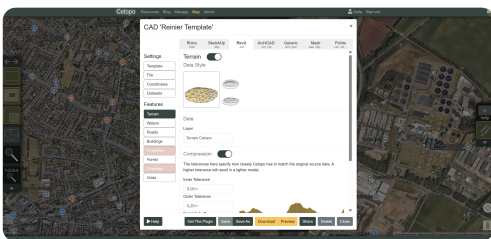
### Step One: Site selection

Selecting the project site can be done multiple ways. The most simple is to use the search function to find the site address by name, and then use the rectangle tool to select the area required.



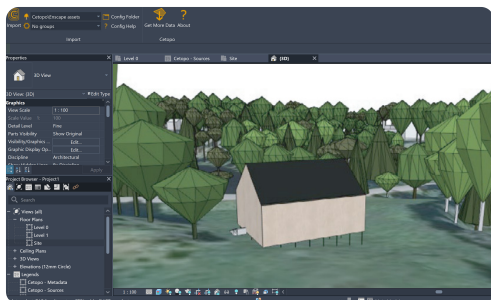
### Step Two: Preview selection

Cetopo offers 2D and 3D previews, to check that the selection is correct before downloading. 3D previews are interactive, and can show how lighting on the site will vary through the day and year, in addition to other useful tools.



### Step Three: Templates

Chose from a variety of pre-set templates, to best suit your needs. There are templates for 2D CAD as well as Revit, Archicad and Sketch-up. These can also be edited and shared between teams.



### Step Four: BIM import

Cetopo offers plugins for Archicad and Revit to streamline workflow. Download the relevant plug in and bring the model into the software. Models can then be edited alongside building models.
